


Efforts Toward the Reduction of Greenhouse Gas Emissions

Scope of emissions	Definition for each scop	2030 target	
Scope1	Direct GHG emissions from the company itself (fuel combustion, industrial processes)	Greenhouse gas emissions (Scope1+2) will be reduced by 50% from 2018	
Scope2	Indirect emissions from the use of electricity, heat and steam supplied by other companies		
Scope3	Emissions of other companies related to the company's activities	Emission levels are calculated and efforts are made to reduce them	


Status of GHG emissions (SBT)
