

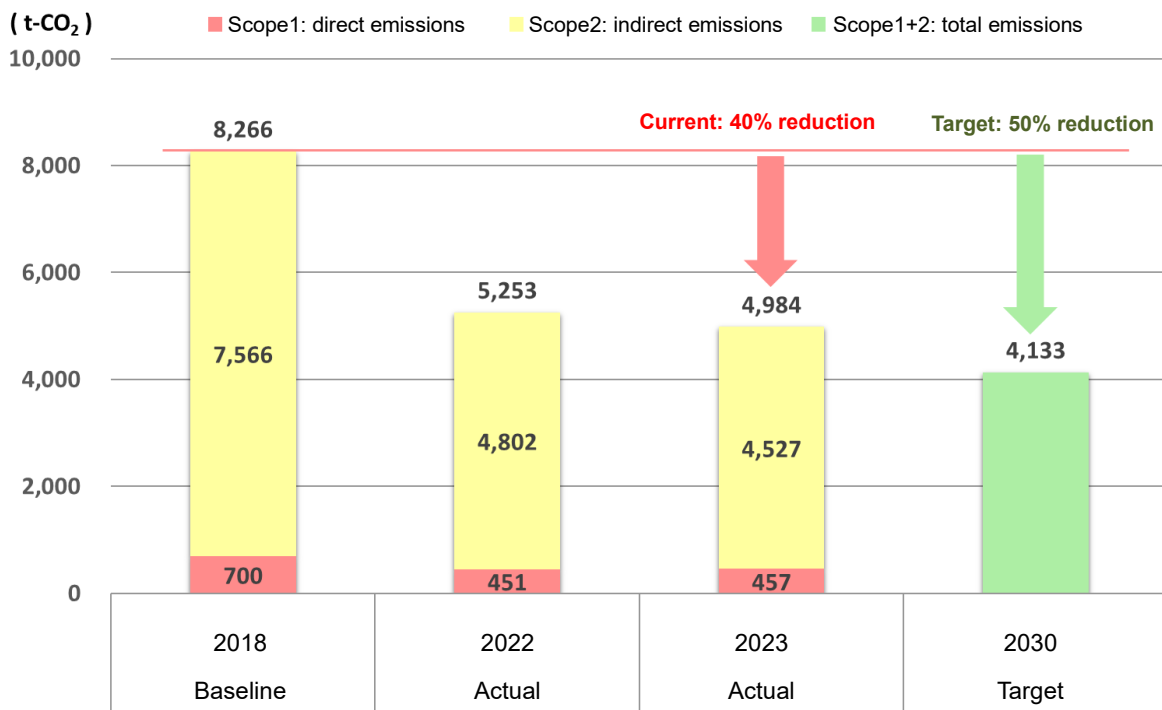
Status of efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions

Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions Reduction Targets

Scope of emissions	Definition for each scope	2030 target
Scope 1	Direct GHG emissions from the company itself (fuel combustion, industrial processes)	Greenhouse gas emissions (Scope1+2) will be reduced by 50% compared to 2018.
Scope 2	Indirect emissions from the use of electricity, heat and steam supplied by other companies	
Scope 3	Emissions of other companies related to the company's activities	Emission levels are calculated and efforts are made to reduce them.
